River Valley Historical Society River Valley School House



The River Valley Historical Society is a dedicated group of people who are working to preserve the River Valley School House for generations to come. It is a unique prairie school house that was built in 1896. It is used as a camping and picnic spot by local schools and travelers to the area.

In 2021 the Historical Society took on the major project to repair and preserve the exterior stone walls of the school house. An estimated 100 hours or work was put into this project. The Virden Area Foundation proved a grant of \$5000.00 to assist with the restoration of the River Valley School House #SD 879.

The Virden Area Foundation is a charitable organization that brings together community-minded people to build a permanent endowment fund from which it supports community projects in the Virden area through the making of grants.
